OVERVIEW

The **Marine Corps Executive Forum** strengthens the connection between America's Marines and civilian leaders of businesses, organizations, academia, and faith-based groups in communities large and small throughout the country. Since 2006, the program has exposed civilian leaders from across the United States to the Corps' operational capabilities, current programs, and future initiatives.

During the day-long program, participants are treated as Marines, learning the power of the individual Marine – an honorable and courageous professional warrior, committed to serving the Nation and its citizens. The program is limited to 25 participants or less to ensure a more personal experience with the Marines. There are four forums per year, one Friday per month from May to August.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered, an applicant must meet all eligibility requirements and submit an application comprising of all required materials.

Participants must be:

- » A citizen of the United States.
- » A business/civic leader or industry expert.
- » In good health and able to stand up for 30 minutes at a time over a 12-16 hour day.
- » Able to financially afford transportation and lodging costs associated with traveling to and from the program location.
- » Able to attain the permission and support of his/her employer for participation.

Participants cannot:

- » Be employees or retirees of the Department of Defense, military or civilian services.
- » Have served in the military in either an active duty or reserve capacity within the last 10 years.
- » Have extensive knowledge of the Marine Corps.
- » Work for or be affiliated with a Department of Defense contract.
- » Be associated with the media unless working in a business operations or management capacity.
- » Have attended a service academy.

Applications and a bio or resume should be submitted electronically to MCEF@usmc.mil. Please indicate "Marine Corps Executive Forum Application" in the subject line. Participants who are selected will be notified by email six weeks prior to the program. The email will include an official invitation providing details and logistics.
