Prince Philip, husband of Queen Elizabeth of England, occupied this room during the American Bicentennial celebration. General and Mrs. Wilson at that time, were nervous about the Prince staying at the Home, but he put her at ease the moment he arrived. As he entered the front door, he took her hand and said, "My dear lady, however did you get stuck with me?"

In 2007, General and Mrs. Conway, the 34th Commandant, met Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip when they visited America. They explained to the Prince that a room in the Home was named after him. He exclaimed, "But I'm not dead yet!" The General assured him, "In our country, you don't have to be."

Vandegrift Table


