



EAST-CENTRAL FRONT

JANUARY 1951 - MARCH 1952 : Marine Operations in the East - Central Front of Korea covered a series of actions ranging from small unit anti-guerrilla patrols to joint UN operations directed by the new theater commander, General Ridgway. While initial truce talks commenced in Kaesong, Marines were in the forefront of battle in places like the "Punchbowl" and fought inch by inch for ownership of terrain in the "Hill Battles".
