Subj: ILLUSTRATIVE PRINTS OF 1983 AND 1991 MARINE CORPS UNIFORMS

Ref: (a) MCO P1020.34F (MCUR)

1. Purpose. To provide instructions for the acquisition and display of the Marine Corps Uniforms 1983, and U.S. Marines in the Middle East, 1991 prints. These prints are intended as a historical record of the various uniforms worn by Marines and as a pictorial representation of the uniform regulations contained in the reference.

2. Cancellation. MCO 5750.8.

3. Information

a. The two sets of uniform prints consist of 13 prints, each depicting a different category of uniforms. Accompanying each print is a printed explanatory text that provides historical background data, nomenclature, and the applicable paragraphs from the reference.

b. While the sets of prints provide an excellent pictorial representation of the appearance of various uniforms, neither these prints nor the accompanying explanatory texts supersede the information contained in the reference or current Marine Corps bulletins in the 1020 series.

c. The sets consist of the following prints:

- (1) Officers' Service Uniforms
- (2) Enlisted Service Uniforms
- (3) Officers' Blue Dress Uniforms
- (4) Enlisted Blue Dress Uniforms
- (5) Evening Dress Uniforms
- (6) Mess Dress and White Dress Uniforms

- (7) U.S. Marine Band (The President's Own)
- (8) Marine Barracks Ceremonial Uniforms
- (9) Aviation Clothing
- (10) Field Uniforms
- (11) Uniform Accessories and Officer Insignia
- (12) Uniform Accessories and Enlisted Insignia
- (13) U.S. Marines in the Middle East, 1991

4. Action

a. Every command at the battalion level and higher will prominently display these uniform prints.

b. Print Acquisition

(1) Requests for print sets should be addressed to the Commandant of the Marine Corps (HDS) and must include justification.

(2) Each print and explanatory text is designed to fit a standard General Service Administration (GSA) available frame. The frame designated for the prints and texts are:

(a) Prints. Picture frame, black, 3/4" molding, 16"x20", NSN 7105-00-053-0170.

(b) Texts. Picture frame, black, 1/2" molding, 10"x14", NSN 7105-00-051-1212.

c. Set Display Recommendation

(1) The print and the text may be displayed separately or together. Whichever method is chosen, explanatory texts should be placed in a position that is contiguous to their corresponding uniform print.

(2) Areas that are suitable for display include:

(a) Company offices

(b) Higher headquarters common areas

- (c) Career Planners' offices
- (d) Dining facilities
- (e) Cash sales/Marine Corps exchange uniform shops
- (f) Recruiting offices

5. Reserve Applicability. This Order is applicable to the Marine Corps Reserve.
