MARINE CORPS BASE CAMP LEJEUNE, N.C. – Lance Cpl. Christopher P. J. Levy, 21, of Ramseur, N.C., died Dec. 10 of wounds sustained Dec. 7 while conducting combat operations in Helmand province, Afghanistan.

Levy was an infantryman with 1st Battalion, 6th Marine Regiment, Regimental Combat Team 8, 2nd Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Lejeune, N.C. He joined the Marine Corps in June of 2009 and was promoted to Lance Corporal on Aug. 1, 2010.

He deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom from August 2010 to May 2011. His most recent deployment was in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.

His awards include the Combat Action Ribbon, Navy Unit Commendation Ribbon, National Defense Service Medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon, and NATO Medal - ISAF Afghanistan.
