# eMARINE

... delivering readiness information to Marines & those who support them

As in any relationship, the key to success is communication. Without communication, information is not received and signals can be misinterpreted. The Marine Corps has created a solution to ensure the relationship it endures with its service members and families to do not fail due to "lack of communication."

eMarine is a new website designed for Unit Commanders, Family Readiness Officers, Marines, and their families, both immediate and extended, to receive announcements, information, downloadable files, forms, videos, and support services relative to each assigned duty station around the world.

This website, [www.emarine.org](http://www.emarine.org), will take you to a one stop shop, very similar to MilitaryOneSource, but be

customized for your unit. Members will need to create a User ID and Password to access eMarine and then they will request permission to view the unit they are assigned too. Once the active-duty member is linked with eMarine, they will be eligible to add up to four subscribers to their account.

eMarine goes where you go. Marines and family members will have the opportunity to communicate with their Family Readiness Officers and have an idea about what their new and current units are doing. Having access to a website that provides resources and a routine schedule will create a sense of belonging for family members

Because Operational Security (OPSEC) is essential and can determine the fate of any unit, it is important for all Marines and families to become accustomed to utilizing this website for official information,

direction, and trusted resources to assist you with your combat multipliers. Family readiness is a combat multiplier and the Marine Corps wants to provide it most valuable assets, the Marine and its family, with the best available support.

Log on today and look around the homepage of eMarine. Soon the MBW eMarine page will be available for Marines and families to access on a regular basis.



