The U.S. Marine Corps (USMC), following Section 102(2)(c) of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and Council on Environmental Quality Regulations (40 Code of Federal Regulations Parts 1500-1508) gives notice that a Supplemental Environmental Assessment (SEA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) have been prepared in support of the proposal to construct, operate, and maintain a 270-degree tactical automated reaction range/urban sniper range and related support facilities northwest of Range 130 at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, California. The purpose of the Proposed Action is to provide for the development of additional and more refined Marine Special Operations Company skills and to accommodate a more synergistic approach to training.
