California School Age Attendance Requirements

California Education Code 48200 requires school attendance for all children between the ages of 6 and 18. Kindergarten is considered part of the regular school program. A child must be 5 years of age or older on or before December 2 to attend kindergarten, and must be 6 years old on or before December 2 to attend first grade.

Quick Checklist for School Moves

- Student's Social Security Number
- Student's Health Record (Immunization, etc)

- Proof of Residency/Military Orders (utility bills, lease/escrow deed, housing contract)

- Course Description Book/Grading Scale (if available for 6th grade and above)
- Copy of the Cover of Each Textbook or the Title Page
- School Profile/Handbook
- School Web Page (URL)

School Records:

- Copy of Cumulative Folder (only the copy mailed between schools is considered official)
- Current Schedule
- Report Cards
- Withdrawal Grades or Progress Reports
- Test Scores (Standardized or Special Program Testing, etc.)
- Other

Special Programs Records as Appropriate:

- Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- Individual Accommodation Plan(504)Gifted Program Description
- English as a Second Language (ESL) or Bilingual Education
- At-Risk or Other Action Plans for Classroom Modifications
- Other
