

Scrap Wood Collection and Removal Chit
Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, North Carolina

1. You are hereby authorized to collect scrap wood from the Air Station Land Clearing and Inert Debris (LCID) Landfill. This authorization is being granted gratuitously by the U.S. Government and can be revoked at any time. By your signature below you acknowledge and agree to the terms of this authorization.
2. The landfill is fully operational and inherently dangerous to those who enter the premises. Anyone entering the premises assumes all risk of personal injury and property damage, including, but not limited to, severe injury or death resulting from or during collection of wood from the landfill.
3. You agree to release and hold harmless the United States Government, including the United States Marine Corps and its officers, employees, agents, personnel, successors and assigns, from any and all claims, damages, liabilities, losses, injuries, deaths, and costs and expenses including attorney's fees, and costs of suits arising out of or claimed on account of the granting of access to the MCAS Cherry Point landfill and the wood scraps thereby provided by the United States Government. You agree that this release also binds your family, heirs, assigns, administrator, and executor.
4. All persons must provide full legal name and signature. Children under 18 years of age are not authorized to enter the Landfill.
5. To facilitate future scrap wood collection and removal efforts, you have the option to be added to an Authorized User List (AUL). Inclusion on the AUL will eliminate the need for a Scrap Wood Collection And Removal Chit each time you enter the landfill for scrap wood collection and removal. The AUL will be valid until December 2004 at which time a new Scrap Wood Collection and Removal Chit will need to be completed and signed. The government reserves the right to remove a name from the AUL or discontinue the AUL at any time. Inclusion is entirely voluntary.

_____ **Initial here if you wish to be added to the Authorized User List.** By initialing, you acknowledge that the waivers set forth in this document will remain in effect for any and all visits made to the Air Station Land Clearing and Inert Debris (LCID) Landfill. Please note that there will be a time lag between submittal of this form and addition to the AUL.
