PCS Key Points

Guidance Issued

Last week the Marine Corps issued two notices regarding PCS moves:

- MARADMIN 162/20 provided instructions regarding movement from CONUS to OCONUS locations.
- MARADMIN 167/20 provided guidance on CONUS movement for PCS and TDY. Marines with orders effective during this period should email their monitors.

Transitioning Marines

Marines pending retirement or separation during this period may proceed in accordance with their official orders.

Temporary Duty

Marines whose TAD ends while this policy is in effect are authorized to return to their home stations. Check with your unit's administrators regarding entitlements.

Checked out already?

Marines who are in receipt of original orders from their IPAC and have already initiated travel, including intermediate stops, are authorized to continue to their final destination.

Limited Exceptions

Marines may request an exception to stop movement for compelling cases where the travel is: (1) determined to be mission essential, (2) necessary for humanitarian reasons, or (3) warranted due to extreme hardship.
